

Metal Fabricator

A local construction company, with annual revenues exceed \$5 million with a combination of domestic and international projects, has a current opening for the position of Metal Fabricator, which is more fully described below. The position is full time and salaried with compensation commensurate with industry standard and experience level. The successful candidate will have full autonomy of their department and will be expected to be results oriented, driven and motivated individual.

Primary Responsibilities

Include, but may not be limited to:

1. Fabricates and assembles structural metal products, such as framework or ice rink dasher frames, pump skids, tanks, stacks, and metal parts for ice rink manufactured items according to job order, verbal instructions, and blueprints: Develops layout and plans sequence of operations, applying knowledge of welding and steel fabrication, stock allowances for thickness, machine and welding shrinkage, and physical properties of metal fabrication.
2. Measures, locates and marks bending and cutting lines onto easy workpiece and workflow processing.
3. Sets up and operates fabricating machines, such as brakes, rolls, shears, flame cutters, and drill presses.
4. Designs and constructs templates and frames for continuous welding and fabrication.
5. Verifies conformance of workpiece to specifications, using square, ruler, and measuring tape.
6. May fabricate and assemble metal products and other ferrous and non-ferrous alloys.
7. May set up and operate machine tools associated with fabricating shops, such as radial drill press, table saws, plasma cutter and misc air and power tools.
8. Reports directly to the shop foreman.
