

PRODUCTION LABORER - WELDER

Purpose:

Use hand welding and flame-cutting equipment, such as MIG welding machines and gas torches to fabricate metal components used in the finished product.

Production Manager

Responsibilities:

Essential Functions:

- Cutting, fitting, tacking and finish welding tubular steel frames and other assemblies in accordance with drawings or verbal instructions provided.
- Grind, file or otherwise dress appearance of finished products prior to shipment.
- Set-up and operate drill press.
- Set-up and operate ironworker in shear and punch.
- Set-up and operate cold saw.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

Completion of basic welding course or two- or three-months experience in a welding position or completion of in-house instruction.

Other Qualifications:

- Capable of reading a simple three-view engineering drawing.
- Capable of reading a tape measure to the sixteenth inch increments.
- Capable of performing basic math such as adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing whole numbers, fractions and decimals.

Physical Requirements:

- Work is performed while standing, sitting and/or walking.
- Requires bending, squatting, crawling, climbing, reaching.
- Requires the ability to lift, carry, push or pull medium weights, up to 100 pounds.



 Requires activities involving being around moving machinery, exposure to marked changes in temperature and humidity, and exposure to dust, fumes and gases.
